Proposed changes 建議更新內容	 6.5.d. Should a competitor ceased to be a bona fide member of the Club who made the original entry: in Singles, the entry will become invalid from the date the player ceased to be a member of the Club who made the original entry. The forthcoming match will be forfeited to the opponent. in Team competition, the entry will still valid however, the player need to be replaced with another club member who is eligible to play as substitute. 6.5.d. 當一名參賽者不再擁有為其報名球會的正式會員身份時: 在單人賽中,該球員的參賽資格將由為其報名球會的會員身份終止之日開始失效,隨後比賽之對手將自動勝出賽事。

Background 背景	After the recent ruling of allowing a player who changed club during an open competition to continue playing in the competition, the HKLBA has received quite a number of feedbacks on the case. The general view was that the competitor was entered by a HKLBA affiliate club and if the player ceased to be a member of such club, the entry should become invalid. Such entry should not be transferable. After consulting the opinion of the National Championships Panel, the VP – National Championships proposed this change to the existing bye-laws to clearly define the handling method for future cases.
