REPORT ON THE 2010 WORLD CUP INDOOR SINGLES & WORLD JUNIOR CUP OUTDOOR SINGLES

1. INTRODUCTION

This World Bowls annual event took place from 22 April – 29 April at the Warilla Bowls & Recreation Club in New South Wales, Australia. This venue is located on the south coast of Australia around 100km south of Sydney. The weather was generally fine, ranging around 20-25 degrees Celsius. The competition venue was a very large recreation complex with an 8 rink indoor green (and 2 natural and 2 artificial grass outdoor greens).

2. THE TEAM

The HK team comprised of the winners of our local indoor runner-up Stephen Sy (LBTC) (winner Danny Ho was not available) and champion Tammy Tham and the juniors Alex Kwok and Vanessa Ng (Youth Development Team). Our players represented HK for the first time.

3. PREPARATION PRACTICE

Alex and Vanessa had their practise sessions at Victoria Park outdoor lawn bowls greens once per week coached by the coaches of YDT. Stephen and Tammy practised weekly at CCC's indoor greens. Tammy arrived at the Warilla Bowls & Recreation Club a week earlier than the others for practise.

4. FORMAT OF PLAY

The format was sets play of two 9 ends each followed by a 3 end tie-breaker if required. The teams were drawn into 2 sections for the men's and women's open, and single sections for the juniors for full round robin games. The top players from the open-aged sections then played quarter-finals, semi-finals and finals for the cup with the remainder teams placings determined by their sectional overall results. The junior's results were determined at the end of their single section play.

5. THE COMPETITORS

There were 25 participating countries - Australia, Brunei, Canada, China, Cook Islands, Cyprus, Fiji, Guernsey, Hong Kong, India, Israel, Japan, Macao, Malaysia, Malta, Namibia, New Zealand, Norfolk Island, Papua New Guinea, Philippines, Singapore, South Africa, Thailand, United Arab Emirates and United States of America.
