# Hong Kong Lawn Bowls Association Council Meeting on 24 January 2011 at HKFC Notes from VP National League

#### 1. Complaint from ILBC about GBLBC

The panel received a complaint from ILBC about GBLBC not booking the green timely and change the green setup in SWH. The panel studied the case and had following recommendations:

- o Issue a warning letter to GBLBC for not booking the green timely. The panel believed that three (3) days is a reasonable period for home side to start the booking of green after receiving the approval of match schedule.
- o Any neglect of panel instruction, such as change the green set up in SWH by the clubs, may be referred to disciplinary panel.

#### 2. Premier League 2011

- Proposed fixture start date: 30-April. Second half stat at 20-Aug. Actual dates and grouping of divisions will depend on the number of entries.
- o Entry will be open on 1 Feb. Entry deadline is 7 March
- Division grouping and fixture dates will be finalized on 10-Mar
- The draft fixture will be issued to all convenors for comment on 17-Mar.
- o On next Council meeting 21-Mar, we can approve the fixture and start the booking of greens.

# REPORT ON THE 5<sup>th</sup> SIME DARBY ASIA PACIFIC MERDEKA INDOOR BOWLS CHAMPIONSHIP 2010

#### 1. INTRODUCTION

This event was hosted by the Malaysia Lawn Bowls Federation (MLBF) at the Bayuernas Indoor Bowls Stadium, Klang, Selangor, Malaysia. The Host was supported by a generous sponsor, who covered the hotel accommodation, breakfast and lunch costs for each country's 2 players and a Manager.

The competition venue was In fact an 8 -rink covered bowls 'Greengauge' green encompassed by solid walls/structures with open space above and a magnificent curved space-frame covering the encompassing structures and green. The effect was both restful and exciting to be weather protected and be able to enjoy the outdoor airflows and open sky at the same time.

#### 2. THE TEAM

The Hong Kong Team comprised the winners of our 2009 indoor singles competitions Tammy Tam and the Men's 1<sup>st</sup> Runners-up Stephen Sy.

10 practice sessions were held in September, October and November on the HKFC indoor green and the Hong Kong Island East Indoor Venue, much appreciation is given to HKFC for their generosity.

#### 3. FORMAT OF PLAY

The Playing format was Round Robin in 2 sections then the top of each section would go forward to the Semi-Final while the 2<sup>nd</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> placings would play off for the remaining places in the Semi Final.

The Mixed Palrs – each match consisted of 15 ends using the system 2 x 4 x 2, with the Man player to start the match.

Play generally commenced at 9:00am to 7:30pm.

# REPORT ON THE WORLD CHAMPION OF CHAMPIONS 2010 - to the Councilors of the Hong Kong Lawn Bowls Association

#### 1. INTRODUCTION

This World Bowls annual event took place from 22 November to 3 December 2010 at the Norfolk Island Bowling Club at Norfolk Island. This venue is located in the centre of the town center. The club contains 2 outdoor grass greens, with 6 rinks each. The weather was fine during the whole tournament with strong wind and some drizzle sometimes. The player was required to bear their uniform, flight travel and all evening meal costs.

#### 2. THE TEAM

The tournament was open to all current Singles champions of each national authority. Hong Kong representative was Peggy Ma from Filipino Club and Heron Lau from Kowloon Bowling Green Club. Both were the winner of the National Singles in 2009.

#### 3. PREPARATION PRACTICE

Peggy and Heron arrived Norfolk Island three days earlier before the tournament. Both practiced all 3 days times in the host during this week.

#### 4. FORMAT OF PLAY

The format was sets play that was two sets of 9 ends followed by a 3 ends tie-breaker if required. The players were grouped into 2 sections playing a full round robin games. The top player will qualify for semi-final and  $2^{nd}$  and  $3^{nd}$  of the section will qualify for the play-off for the semi-final.

#### 5. THE COMPETITORS

There was 23 countries participant the tournament. 21 countries participated in the Men's and 20 participated Women's competition. They were Australia, Botswana, Canada, Cook Islands, Cyprus, England, Hong Kong China, Ireland, Israel, Jersey, Malaysia, Namibla, Netherlands, New Zealand, Norfolk Island, Philippines, Scotland, Singapore, South Africa, Spain, Swaziland, United State and Wales
