#### Council Meeting on 21 March 2011 at USRC - Notes from VP National League

#### 1. Triples League 2010 penalties

The League Panel made following rulings in accordance with the bye-law. All penalties had been effective in website.

- Deduct 2 points from CLP-B for a registered player played down in M4555. Add 2 points to HKSAP-A for their loss in M4555.
- Deduct 2 points from KBGC-F for a registered player played down in M4572.
- Deduct 2 points from KCC-E for a registered player played down in M4574.
- Deduct 2 points from CLP-C for a registered player played down in M4582.
- Deduct 2 points from KCC-E for a registered player played down in M4671.
- Deduct 2 points from KCC-E for a registered player played down in M4772. Add 2 points to KBGC-F for their loss in M4772.
- Deduct 2 points from CLP-B for a registered player played down in M4854.
- Deduct 2 points from KCC-E for a registered player played down in M4973.
- Deduct 2 points from KCC-D for a player playing two games in same fixture date. Add 2 points to USRC-C for their loss in M4975 vs KCC-D.
- Deduct 1 point from USRC-A for their late verification in M5013.
- Deduct 0.5 point from IRC-C for an unmatched player name in M5085.

#### 2. Dispute from CLP about the rulings of a registered player played down

CLP did not submit the registered players list before its fourth match. The panel selected the list for them. In a rescheduled game, one of the registered players playing down and League panel deducted them 2 points in accordance with the bye-law.

With the dispute, the Panel re-studied the case and had the recommendations:

- o Communication fault and late submission are not acceptable excuses.
- o It was the Convenor's responsibility to register the players. If nil input, the panel had full authority to select the list for them.
- Whether the game played in advance is irrelevant to the breaches of bye-law.
- The Panel recommended to sustain the ruling, that is deduct 2 points from CLP-B.
