## REPORT ON THE 6<sup>TH</sup> SIME DARBY ASIA PACIFIC MERDEKA INDOOR BOWLS CHAMPIONSHIP 2011 (HELD 3 – 8 OCTOBER 2011)

### 1) Introduction

This event was hosted by the Malaysian Lawn Bowls Federation (MLBF) at the Bayuemas Indoor bowls Stadium, Klang, Selangor, Malaysia. The host was supported by a sponsor who covered the hotel accommodation, breakfast and lunch, and the costs of each represented country's players and manager.

### 2) The Team

The Hong Kong team comprised the winners of the 2010 Indoor Singles Competitions who were Tammy Tham and Sanlia Wong, and Danny Ho and Wan Kwong Hoi who were the men's winners. Unfortunately, Mr. Wan had to withdraw prior to departure from HK for health reasons. Six practice sessions were held in August and September on CCC's indoor greens in preparation for the competition.

### 3) Format of Play

The Singles were played in sets of 7-7-5. The mixed Triples consisted of 15 ends and had to be finished within 2 hours. Singles matches were played both on indoor and outdoor greens. Mixed Triples were played only on indoor greens.

### 4) The Competitors

There were 13 participating countries including Australia, Brunei, Canada, China, Fiji, Hong Kong, India, Macao, New Zealand, Philippines, Singapore, Thailand and Malaysia.

### 5) The Results

- a) Women's Singles: 1<sup>st</sup> Runner-up (silver medal)  
Tammy Tham won the prize money of US\$2,500.
- b) Men's Singles: Danny Ho came second in the group stage, ranked 10<sup>th</sup> place overall
- c) Mixed Triples: Second in the group stage, ranked 6<sup>th</sup> overall

### 6) Remarks

A doping test was performed on selected players. Sanlia Wong of the HK Team was selected and underwent a doping test.

Each player in the competition was limited to participating in a maximum of 2 events. It was decided that our players would participate in the Men's and Women's Singles and the Mixed Triples.

### 7) Looking Forward

At the closing ceremony, Tun Ahmad Sarji Bin Abdul Hamid, President of the Bowls Asia and MLBF announced more top players will be invited to take part in the competition next year.

2<sup>nd</sup> Japan International Open  
(29-30 Oct 2011, Kobe, Japan)

Manager's Report

This tournament was organised by Bowls Japan and was held on 29 – 30 October 2011 at Kobe. Hong Kong, China, Macao, Singapore, Thailand and U.A.E were invited to take part and was joined by the Japan national team and eight other local teams.

The venue, the Shiawase-no-mura Green was located inside rehabilitation and caring centre, the hotel we were staying are 5 mins walking distance from the green. There were 2 greens at the venue, which contains 6 rinks and 3 rinks respectively. The speed of the green was 8.5 seconds which is a bit slower than what the team expected. It took sometimes for the team to get used to the slow and very uneven surface.

Our team arrived Kobe in the evening of 27<sup>th</sup> Oct. On 28<sup>th</sup>, we practiced at the venue in fine, sunny and warm weather. On the 1<sup>st</sup> day of the competition, it's a warm and sunny day. On the second day, the weather changed to become cloudy and drizzling at the end. Fortunately, the tournament was completed without further interruption.

Hong Kong lost their 1<sup>st</sup> game 6:14 to Japan National Team and then lost their 2<sup>nd</sup> game 12-16 to Yokohama. The 3<sup>rd</sup> and final game of the session, the team bounced back to won 31:6 to Tokyo and qualified to play at the Plate section.

The team started well at the 2<sup>nd</sup> day won Kobe North 15:10 at the quarter final. However, the team lost to U.A.E at the very last end 10:11 and required to play at the bronze medal playoff. The team won Akashi 14:5 to finished 3<sup>rd</sup> at the plate section.

Overall, the team performed well and demonstrated team cooperation.

Bowls Japan announced that they would like to hold this event again in two years time.
