Notes from VP National League

League Panel rulings

HKCC-B was deducted 2 points due to one team used 3 substitutes in resumed game M0665. CCC-E was awarded 2 points for their lost to the defaulting team. HKCC disputes and as recommended by Disciplinary Panel, League panel issues warnings to HKCC and CCC that their agreement to ignore the score of a played end is in breach of bye-2.9. HKCC made an appeal on both panels decisions. The case is now handled by an Appeals Panel

The League Panel reminded all convenors about bye-law 2.9 that all resumed games should be restarted with the scores standing as they were when the match was stopped. Change of score is NOT allowed, not even one single end.

Triples League 2013

The League Panel recommended the game to be started on 07/12/2013 for divisions with 10 sides and finished by 22/02/2014.

The proposed format is 3 woods triples in 16 ends, with counter proposals on 14 and 18 ends.

Recommendation on the draw of a Rearranged game

If a game was rearranged before the start of game, both sides can rearrange the line-up and perform the draw again in the rearranged game.
