League Panel rulings

Deduct 4 points from CELBC-B for their failure to arrive in M2981. The case was under dispute and was handled by Disciplinary Panel.

Triples League 2013

The fixture v2 is final.

All rearranged games should be fixed by 13 Dec. Home sides should make their offers by 29 Nov.

The League Panel rejected CdeR request to change the green after the fixture was finalized.

Recommendation on the bye-law changes

The League Panel recommended to change the bye-law 2.8.a and 2.8.e to extend the period for postponed game from 15 days to 22 days.

The League Panel recommended to add a new bye-laws 2.17 on provision of green. As a guideline, a booking of 4 hours should be reasonably sufficient for a league game.

WSC proposal on start time of Sunday games

The proposal was circulated to all convenors for comment. Will discuss it in next Council meeting.

The panel upheld the prevailing interpretation of clause 6.9.g and h of Bye-laws and ruled that SLY was a neutral venue.

CdeR asked which player would lose its position in the team. The panel upheld the prevailing application of clause 6.7.e and ruled that the player who misses the game when the substitute plays his second game would lose its position.
