1. Men National Fours Championships 2018

Due to the QF 1 player - Imen Tang represented Hong Kong China Squad to participate in Australian Open between 6 and 20 June, 2018 in Gold Coast, Australia, QF and SF was postponed to 24 June which was approved by National Championships Panel.

2. Women Indoor Singles 2018

Due to the players (Ada Lai and Phyllis Wong) represented Hong Kong China Squad to participate in Australian Open between 6 and 20 June, 2018 in Gold Coast, Australia, QF 1 will be postponed to 3 July which was approved by National Championships Panel.

3. Mixed Fours Competition 2018 (Ref. SF2)

Home side is requested to reschedule the SF due to the two players out of town. Panel rejected the request.

4. 2018 National Championship Finals Day – Summer

2018 National Championships Finals Day – Summer will be scheduled on 1 July, 2018 at FC.

Notes from VP Development

1. The Hong Kong Lawn Bowls Association has introduced a brand new youth training scheme for aspiring youth bowlers. The training scheme came into effect at the same time as the Hong Kong Youth Development Team (HKYDT) extended its age limit to until a bowler reaches 29 years of age.

Bowlers aged 28 years of age or below who is not a member of the HKYDT but want to enjoy the training and benefits available to the HKYDT can apply to join the youth training scheme. This scheme is available to former HKYDT members as well as current members of any HKLBA affiliated clubs.

Interested youth bowlers are welcome to join the youth training scheme under the following conditions:

- a. Be a regular player (at least 70%) in the HKLBA Premier and Triples leagues for any club whilst participating in the scheme,
- b. Committed to attend a minimum of 70% of regular training arranged by HKYDT on Sunday morning generally at Tai Po and Wednesday evening at Victoria Park / Wu Shan, training venues are subject to venue's availability,

- c. Committed to represent HKYDT in at least two Premier National Championships and/or the Hong Kong International Bowls Classic Singles. Premier National Championships means National Singles, National Pairs, National Triples and National Fours,
- d. Abide by the rules and regulations of the HKLBA and HKYDT, and
- e. Abide by the HKLBA Players Code of Ethics and Conduct.

As a member of this training scheme, a bowler is also qualified for international events and training arranged by and for HKYDT.

Interested bowlers are encouraged to apply in writing to the HKLBA at aa1@hklba.org. All applications will be considered in confidence by the Vice President-Development, Youth Development Coaching Director and HKYDT Co-Ordinator.

Successful applicant is required to seek the consent in writing from their Club Convenor (if any) agree to allow the applicant to represent HKYDT in at least two of the Premier National Championships and/or the Hong Kong International Bowls Classic Singles.

2. We have granted a Funding Scheme for Youth Sports Exchange from LCSD to conduct an overseas training camp for 5 boys and 5 girls from Youth Development Team between 10th and 19th August, 2018 in Glasgow, Scotland.
3. Under-25 Age Group Lawn Bowls Championships 2018 will be held at Island East Sports Centre and Yuen Chau Kok Sports Centre on 15 and 22 July, 2018. A total of 82 players participated in this event and the fixture was issued last week.
