Notes from VP National League

1. League panel ruling

- Deduct two points from IRC-C for one tied B bowler playing downward in M25041
- Deduct one point from CSD-B from late verify in M26092
- HKYDT-B failed to arrive M23072 due to the public event in Tuen Mun on 19/9. League panel recommended to waive their penalty due to safety considerations as most of the HKYDT players are under 18.
- Between 1 to 7 Oct, there are public events throughout the region. Many players cannot arrive the venue due to the traffic and safety concerns. League panel proposed to waive the penalty of 'failure to arrive' during this period. Please note that this is a special case and should not be considered as any preceding reference.
- CCC submit a reschedule request due to two players representing HK in Japan Open, League panel
 overlooked that KH Lee is not a CCC-A regular player and approved the request. League panel
 withdrew the approval subsequent to the findings. CCC disputed about the withdrawal decision.
 League panel reviewed the case again and upheld the decision on rejecting CCC reschedule request.

2. Green availability for reschedule games

- Taking the consideration of bowler safety, traffic conditions, and green availability, on 9 Oct league panel proposed to relax the restriction of playing the rescheduled games within 22 days. However, all rescheduled games must be finished two days before the last match. If the game cannot be finished by that time, both sides will be treated as "failure to arrive".
- Since HKLBA has cancelled the Classic, and League panel has relaxed the 22 days reschedule constraints, hope all Premier League matches will finish as planned.

3. YLLBC proposal

- 1) no evening games arrangement,
- 2) cancel Triples League 2019

4. Triples League 2019

- After the entry deadline, we received 114 entries in men and 63 sides in women.
- A draft fixture will be issued on 1 Nov and it has to be finalized on 4 Nov.

5. SBI

- SBI submitted an entry form to join Triples League 2019 and will use ALC as their home venue

6. HKFC propose to change bye-law 2.11

- HKFC proposed to remove the restriction of bowlers not being allowed to play for another side in same division.
