Notes from VP - National League

1. Green maintenance delay

POC was closed from 14 May to 20 July.

Tai Po green re-opening was deferred due to the maintenance work being affected by the heavy rain.

The League panel granted a special approval that all affected home games of POC and Tai Po can be played before 10 August or within 22 days after its opening.

2. Request to change home green

ELBC applied to change their home green from YCK to ALC.

TVLBC applied to change their home green from VP to ALC.

According to this premier league entries, ALC is not full now.

3. Postponed games in public venue

As per LCSD policy, games can be re-allocated within 14 days, subject to green availability.

If it takes more than 14 days, the green fee will be refunded. However, teams need to arrange greens by themselves.

2. National Championship Finals Day – Summer

HKLBA received interest from CdeR and KCC for holding the National Championships Finals Day on 7 August 2022.

As KCC has not held any National Championships Finals Day since 2017 and CdeR was our host in 2019, we would like to confirm that KCC will host the 2022 National Championship Finals - Summer this year.

3. Celebration of the 25th Anniversary of the Establishment of the HKSAR Reunification Cup

Thank you for the support of all the member clubs. Over 200 entries were received after the deadline. The fixture and CoP will be issued shortly.

4. Notifying period for a change to neutral venue in National Competitions

The Panel issued its first warning and suspended penalty to a home team for its failure to notify their opponent at least 72 hours before the next scheduled match. The National Championship Panel would like to remind all teams/competitors to observe the Bye-law 6.9.g.3 (v.17).

5. Shortage of players in National Competitions

Please be reminded of Bye-law 6.8.a "Any team or competitor failing to appear on the green ready to play a match on the date, at the venue and at the appointed or mutually agreed time shall forfeit the match to the opponent." If one or more players are absent from a team, the defaulting team should forfeit the game to their opponents.

6. POC green closed between 14 May and 20 July 2022

HKPBC informed the HKLBA that their green at POC will be closed for official functions between 14 May and 20 July 2022. The National Championship Panel granted a special permission allowing HKPBC teams to change their home green from POC to PSRC for the remaining matches in Mixed Pairs Competition and Novice Singles Competition 2022.
