1. CONFIRMATION OF PREVIOUS MINUTES

The minutes of the previous meeting were confirmed.

2. MATTERS ARISING

3. CORRESPONDENCE

The Hon. Secretary read out the main correspondence received since the last meeting.

- 3.1 26.5.2011 received an email from USRC informing that they intended to host a lawn bowls competition as part of their Centenary Programme on 23 October 2011.
- 3.2 16.6.2011 received an email from John Davison from New Zealand notifying that the Kevin Sinclair Memorial Tournament would be held in HK at a no. of HK Clubs in Oct. 2011. HKLBA has assisted only in how to organize the event and it would be at each Club's discretion to join or not.

4. TREASURER'S REPORT

4.1 Outstanding receivables as at 27 June 2011 was presented. Clubs were reminded to settle as soon as possible amounts that were outstanding, especially those over 90 days.

5. NATIONAL LEAGUE

- 5.1 Without an umpire on duty, the League Panel was difficult to judge any breach on possession of rinks and foot-faulting. Club convenors were advised to remind their bowlers about the basic of "player should not interfere with, annoy or distract in any way to their opponents", which was the core ethics of our sport
- 5.2 Disciplinary panel was following up the complaint from HKFC against GBLBC.

7. DEVELOPMENT

7.1 Lawn bowls demonstration at schools had been launched in May 2011 which was under LCSD's School Sports Programme.

8. TECHNICAL

- 8.1 Umpire training course 2 candidates passed the written exam. and have completed the green exam. It was in the process of exam. paper marking.
- 8.2 Open tender of Soft Bowls would be due on 30 June.
- 8.3 Except a few who had not submitted their profiles, all HK team members' profiles were posted on website.
- 8.4 A "Bowlers Corner" would be created under HKLBA website as online community for bowlers to participate.
- 8.5 Comments from Clubs were sought and conclusion would be submitted to LCSD in response to their booking policies and the proposed conversion of the natural turf bowling greens at Tai Po Waterfront Park into artificial greens.
- 8.6 MEMO would be issued to collect the size of Club's green.
- 8.7 MEMO would be issued to clarify some basic etiquette issues.

10. HKLBA Golden Jubilee Year 2011

- 10.1 World Singles Champion of Champions 2011 (6-13 Nov. 2011, HK)
 - The updated entry was 32 men and 33 women. Since World Bowls required 8 rinks each at KBGC and KCC only, rinks at CdeR and USRC were not required.
 - Clubs would be required to host these players.
- 10.2 HKLBA Golden Jubilee International Mixed Pairs Classic 2011 (14-20 Nov. 2011, HK)
 - 24 out of 33 Clubs have confirmed their entry. Including overseas and sponsored teams, it was expected to have 60 to 72 teams in total were anticipated.
- 10.3 Golden Jubilee souvenir book
 - It was expected to be ready in July or August. All members would get one copy and the books would be dispatched to Clubs.
- 10.4 Golden Jubilee souvenirs
 - Souvenir bowls cloths and jackets would be distributed to members under the 2nd batch.
 - The purchase of souvenirs would follow our Procurement Guidelines and would not exceed our budget.
 - Formal approval from Councillors was granted for the individual items of jackets and bowls bags which individual totals would fall between \$30,001 and \$199,999.
