# 5. NATIONAL LEAGUE

- 5.1 Premier League results and rankings were finalized and posted on website.
- 5.2 All re-arranged games of Triples League were fixed.
- 5.3 The starting time of games on Sundays and public holidays remain unchanged.
- 5.4 Council endorsed VP League to arrange the league prizes according to past practice.

6.1 A report was tabled before the meeting.

# 7. **DEVELOPMENT**

7.1 Under 25 Championship completed successfully on 1 December 2013. A total of 60 players took part in the event (42 boys and 18 girls).

## 8. TECHNICAL

8.1 A meeting was held with LCSD and Architectural Services Department and expressed to express our concerns on the newly refurbished bowling green at Victoria Park. Short-term remedial measures has been taken, while long term improvement proposal would be submitted by the Architectural Services

- Department to LCSD for consideration. It is expected the long term remedial measures would only take place after the completion of Green B.
- 8.2 A new 4-rink indoor bowling green would be built in Tai Po. The project is in design stage and would probably take 4 to 5 years to complete.

# 9. INTERNATIONAL COMPETITIONS

- 9.1 Japan Open (12-14 Oct., 2013, Japan)
  - Team manager's reported was tabled.
- 9.2 2013 National Bocce Elite Match (6-8 Dec. 2013, China)
  - HK team finished 4<sup>th</sup> place out of 10 teams.
- 9.3 World Champion of Champions 2013 (23 Nov.-2 Dec. 2013, New Zealand)
  - Ken Chan and Elisa Cheung ranked 7<sup>th</sup> and 22<sup>nd</sup> out of 25 players each respectively.
- 9.4 Squad Overseas Training Camp and Australian Open (8-23 Feb. 2014, Australia)
  - Due to time constrain, selection report would be submitted to Councillors for approval by 19 December.
- 9.5 Tiger Bowls World Invitation 2014 (15-16 March 2014, HK)
  - LBA would send two YDT teams.
- 9.6 China Open (17-21 March, 2013, China)
  - HK would send one men and one women team.
- 9.7 World Cup Indoor Singles (8-16 April 2014, Australia)
  - The winners of Indoor Singles Tammy Tham and CL Fung confirmed their availability to take part.
- 9.8 The draft of the new "High Performance Panel" was completed for further discussions among Officers. Details would be circulated to Convenors in due course.

# 10. Hong Kong International Bowls Classic 2013 (9-17 November, 2013)

- 10.1 President thanked HKFC, CCC and CdeR for providing indoor greens for the Classic on raining days.
- 10.2 The Classic would be held on Hong Kong side in November 2014. Letters would be sent to Members in seeking provision of venue and facilities.
