THE COACHING SYSTEM

(Updated on 31 August 2023)

The objective of the Lawn Bowls Association of Hong Kong, China (LBA) coaching system is to provide a standardised form of bowls coaching in Hong Kong based on the LBA Coaching Manuals.

Every year LBA will join with the Leisure & Cultural Services Department to organise lawn bowl training courses for the general public. In 2021, 130 courses were organised and it is expected that more courses will be organised in the years to come. In addition to this, the launch of school programs and increased number of fundays all require more coaches.

To achieve our ultimate goal of extending the coverage of the sports in Hong Kong, it is important that such courses are conducted in accordance to the best practice and in a professional manner so that beginners will maintain their interest after the first course.

As of May 2022, there are 79 coaches (Level 1 - 48, Level 2 - 24 & Level 3 - 5) registered with the LBA. To ensure a high quality of coaching standard, the following system is implemented from 2022.

Coach Registration

For the even distribution of coach duties, it is important to maintain an updated record for all the qualified coaches. The Association maintains a list of all qualified coaches and it is updated on a regular basis. All coaches need to re-register every two years and the prevailing registration fee is HK\$1,000. The following documents are required when re-register:

- 1. A valid coach Accreditation card from the Hong Kong Coaching Committee;
- 2. A valid Sexual Conviction Record Check with the Hong Kong Police Force.

Please note that the above documents need to remain valid during the course of your registration. Should any of these documents expired, the coach status will be suspended until they became valid again.

Should the coaches desired to perform coach duties for LCSD's training courses, they are required to register with the LCSD and an interview will be arranged with LCSD to approve such application.

Any coach who does not re-register within two years after the expiry of the previous registration will be de-listed from the LBA Coach List. Application of re-instatement should be forwarded to the Coach Panel for consideration. Applicants may need to go through some of the regular procedures in the process, such as the completion of the Foundation Certificate in Sports Coaching Theory by Hong Kong Sports Institute. (Including two full training courses under the supervision of a qualified coach) and the Sexual Conviction Record Check with the Hong Kong Police Force.

Level 1 Coach Qualification

To ensure a high standard of coaching, all coaches are required to possess suitable qualifications before they can be qualified as a registered coach with the LBA.

The basic requirements for anyone who would like to enroll to a LBA coach training course are:

- 1. At least five years of competitive bowling experience. To prove this, the applicant should have played in the LBA premier league in the last five years;
- 2. Should be an active and able bowler. The applicant should have gained at least four points annually from National Competitions in three of the last five years;
- 3. Recommended by a club lawn bowls convenor and a qualified coach who is on the existing LBA Coach List;
- 4. Pleasant personality and be willing to help develop the sport;
- 5. Physically fit to conduct training courses under demanding environment.

Once an application was received a screening process will be conducted by LBA's Coaching Panel. The successful applicants will be admitted to the Level One Coach Training course organised by LBA. Upon completion of this 3-hours course, the applicant will be required to attend an examination to demonstrate their understanding of coaching and are physically able to becoming a coach. The procedures include:

- 1. Attend the training course by LBA.
- 2. Pass the Skill Test (Lawn bowl skill, presentation skill) and Examination (theory, understanding of the handbook).
- 3. Complete the Foundation Certificate in Sports Coaching Theory by Hong Kong Sports Institute. (Including practice at two full training courses under the supervision of a qualified coach.).
- 4. Complete the Sexual Conviction Record Check with the Hong Kong Police Force.

Exemption:

- 1. Applicants who hold valid lawn bowls coaching licenses from other countries may be exempted for items 2 and 3, subject to validation by the HKSI. The applicant still needs to go through a practice of ONE full training courses under the supervision of a qualified coach.
- 2. Applicants have completed one of the courses validated by the HKSI in the past five years may be exempted for item 3, the courses validated by the HKSI can be found on its website (https://bit.ly/3cmIIqV). The applicant still needs to go through a practice of ONE full training courses under the supervision of a qualified coach.
- 3. Applicants who have represented Hong Kong at international competitions at senior level will be exempted for item 2.

The LBA coach training course will normally organize once a year and all clubs will be informed when it is available.

Level 2 Coach Qualification

Unless special approval was granted from the Coaching Panel, only Level 2 coach or above may conduct training courses that are designed for Intermediate level.

The basic requirements for anyone who would like to enroll to a LBA Level 2 coach training course are:

- 1. A qualified Level 1 coach for at least three years;
- 2. Conducted at least 6 elementary training courses;
- 3. The holder of a valid Coach Accreditation Card issued by the HKSI;
- 4. Active participate in the refresher courses organized by the LBA and the HKSI;
- 5. Satisfactory performance in observing the Coaches' Code of Conduct;
- 6. Sound physical condition.

The procedures are:

- 1. A screening process conducted by LBA's Coaching Panel.
- 2. The successful applicants will be admitted to the Level Two Coach Training Workshop organized by LBA
- 3. Pass an examination to demonstrate their understanding of coaching and are physically able to becoming a coach.
- 4. Complete the Foundation Certificate in Sports Coaching Theory by Hong Kong Sports Institute. (Including practice at two full training courses under the supervision of a qualified coach.).
- 5. Complete the Sexual Conviction Record Check with the Hong Kong Police Force.

Exemption:

- 1. Applicants who hold valid lawn bowls coaching licenses from other countries may be exempted for item 4, subject to validation by the HKSI. The applicant still needs to go through a practice of ONE full training courses under the supervision of a qualified coach.
- 2. Applicants have completed one of the courses validated by the HKSI in the past five years may be exempted for item 4, the courses validated by the HKSI can be found on its website (https://bit.ly/3cmIIqV). The applicant still needs to go through a practice of ONE full training courses under the supervision of a qualified coach.

The LBA L2 coach training course will normally organize every two years and all clubs will be informed when it is available.

Level 3 Coach Qualification

Unless special approval was granted from the Coaching Panel, only Level 3 coach may conduct training courses that are designed for advanced level.

The basic requirements for anyone who would like to enroll to a LBA Level 3 coach training course are:

- 1. A qualified Level 2 coach for at least three years;
- 2. Conducted at least 4 intermediate training courses;
- 3. The holder of a valid Coach Accreditation Card issued by the HKSI;
- 4. Active participate in the refresher courses organized by the LBA and the HKSI;
- 5. Satisfactory performance in observing the Coaches' Code of Conduct;
- 6. Sound physical condition.

The procedures are:

- 1. A screening process conducted by LBA's Coaching Panel.
- 2. The successful applicants will be admitted to the Level Two Coach Training Workshop organized by LBA.
- 3. Pass the examination to demonstrate their understanding of coaching and are physically able to becoming a coach.
- 4. Complete the Advanced Certificate in Sports Coaching Theory course by Hong Kong Sports Institute. (Including practice at two full training courses under the supervision of a qualified coach.).
- 5. Complete the Sexual Conviction Record Check with the Hong Kong Police Force.

The LBA L3 coach training course will normally organize every two years and all clubs will be informed when it is available.

The Coaching System (5)

Coach Manual

To maintain a consistency in the delivery of the coaching courses, LBA has developed a new set of coaching manual for all coaches to follow. Currently there are manuals for Level One and Level Two training courses and is being used by LBA qualified coaches.

Coach Assignment System

A coach assignment system is maintained and operated by the staff of the LBA to ensure the fairness to all coaches. The LBA staff assigns coach on a random basis for courses organized directly by LBA.

For courses organized directly by LCSD's district offices, they will contact the coaches directly for their courses.

Extension Education Program

To maintain a high standard of the coaches and enhance their knowledge, the Coach Panel will organize extension education program for all the coaches throughout the year. It is expected we will have at least two courses or workshop every year and all coaches are compulsory to join.
