National Championships Panel Report on 23rd June 2014

Case Report

The Panel received an email from Ken K.K. Chan (HKYDT) commenting on the current re-scheduling mechanism of individual matches as instigated by his own and his fellow YDT teammate's experience in the Novice Singles. The Panel advised that the current bye-laws (6.9.a and 6.9.h) have afforded flexibility for competitors to re-arrange a match based on mutual agreement under certain circumstances. No further action was taken.

National Championship Finals Day - 2014 Summer

The National Championship Finals Day - 2014 Summer is scheduled on Sunday, 6th July 2014 at HKCC. Eight titles will be decided on the day. Spectators and supporters are most welcome. Light buffet lunch coupons at \$160 each are available for pre-order with LBA. Cash cards for drinks can be purchased on the day.

Semi Finals and Finals venue of Indoor Singles 2014

Two offers to host the semi-finals and finals of the championships were received from CdeR and HKFC – thanks to both clubs. The venue was decided by draw at the LBA annual prize presentation dinner. HKFC was drawn to be the host venue. It is the intention of the Panel to rotate the venue of this event every year, subject to offers and availability of club and public indoor greens at the time.

National Championships/Competitions Results

1. Ronson Au Memorial Mixed Fours Competition 2014 – Candy Ng, George Chan, Angela Chau & K.C. Ching (USRC) are the champions.
2. Thanks to CCC, CdeR, HKPBC and IRC for semi-finals venues of National Fours and Novice Singles.

Indoor Pairs Competition

The inaugural Indoor Pairs Competition 2014 entries closed today. It received strong support with a total of 128 men's and 71 women's teams entered, subject to final confirmation. The Panel is trying out a new procedure to allocate match date and time. If it proves to be successful, this procedure will be implemented for Indoor Singles next year.

Classic Singles Qualifying

Thanks to CdeR, FC, HKFC, KCC & USRC for agreeing to help with their greens. A total of 99 men and 64 women have entered, subject to final confirmation. Number of rinks and time required from each club will be finalized after the fixtures framework is finalized. We will approach the other private clubs which have not confirmed their green availability if necessary. In the worst case scenario, public greens will be hired.
