KCC suggestions

We did not receive any feedback or comments about the proposal. Since there are difficulties to allocate all outstanding games on Sunday afternoon, we propose to keep the status quo and try the best to arrange all league matches on Saturday and Sunday.

YCK venue

We will follow LCSD green booking policy in YCK. Block booking under the name of HKLBA 6 months in advance. HKLBA will pay the green fees (3 months in advance). Under this arrangement, all allocated games with green fees paid will be secured. Member clubs will settle the green fees of all allocated games with HKLBA.

On the competition day, member clubs representative will collect the green on behalf of HKLBA. Please note that if there are two absent case, HKLBA will be blacklisted and not allowed for any block booking.

This policy may be extended to other LCSD venues in future.

HKSAP applied to change home venue from SLY to YCK

National Competition

Men's National Pairs
