### Application to reschedule a match

- a) Any reschedule request arrives with less than 6 days will be treated as "fail to arrive";
- b) Any reschedule request arrives between 6 and 8 days will be deducted 2 points; and
- c) The panel will not handle any request which was due to shortage of players and arrives with more than 8 days in advance.

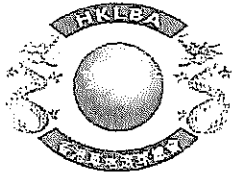

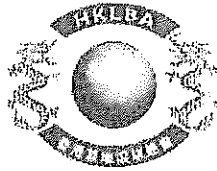

Having received a number of responses to my last e-mail on this subject where most of them agreed that the annual scorecards expenditure should be equally shared by all users, the HKLBA Officers briefly discussed the matter and recommended that with effect from the coming Triples League, an additional \$100 will be charged to the entry fee of every side entered by the Clubs as scorecard expenditures. The same will apply to the 2018 Premier League.

The \$100 goes only to scorecards expenditure and any profit made will go to the HKLBA savings for International events.

For information and sanctioning in the coming HKLBA Council Meeting. If approved, we will cease to accept member clubs sponsorships and will explore more commercial sponsorships for the cover of our future scorecards.
