1. CONFIRMATION OF PREVIOUS MINUTES

The minutes of the previous meeting were confirmed subject to the following amendment:

Item 10.1 The event dates of China Inter-port Competition 2011 should be 21-22 May 2011.

2. MATTERS ARISING

Nil.

3. CORRESPONDENCE

The Hon. Secretary read out the main correspondence received since the last meeting.

3.1 22.4.2011 received an email from Malaysian Bowls Federation inviting HK to send a team to take part in Asia Pacific Indoor Bowls Championship in October 2011 in Malaysia.

4. TREASURER'S REPORT

4.1 Outstanding receivables as at 9 May 2011 was presented. Clubs were reminded to settle as soon as possible amounts that were outstanding, especially those over 90 days.

5. NATIONAL LEAGUE

- 5.1 VP League reminded that all revised games should be fixed before 14 May.
- 5.2 Clubs with more than 1 side should submit the registered players list before their fourth match.
- 5.3 HKFC convenor advised that HKFC outdoor green would be closed for the whole league season. The Councillors agreed that all games in HKFC outdoor would switch to HKFC indoor and be rescheduled, including the last week.

6 NATIONAL COMPETITIONS

- 6.1 Report tabled.
- 6.2 The Finals Day was scheduled on 3 July at CCC.
- 6.3 Due to the tight schedule of competitions in 2011, games were played during Easter Holidays. VP advised that this may not happen again in next year.

7. DEVELOPMENT

7.1 The Inter-schools competition was held at Ap Lei Chau Sports Centre on 1 May which was organized by HKLBA and LCSD, sponsored by Southern District Council. 16 teams with 63 students from 10 secondary and primary schools had entered in the competition.

8. TECHNICAL

8.1 Umpire training course completed. Examination to be held on 25 May.

9. INTERNATIONAL COMPETITIONS

- 9.1 HK Squad Training Camp was successfully held. A full report would be tabled in next meeting.
- 9.2 HK Junior Squad list 2011-12 was tabled and sanctioned by the Councillors.
- 9.3 World Cup & World Junior Cup 2011 (12-20 April 2011, Australia)

- Team manager report to be tabled in next meeting.
- 9.4 Asia Pacific Singles, Mixed Pairs & Mixed Triples Indoor Championship (2-8 Oct. 2011, Malaysia)
 - Keep in view.
- 9.5 MAP International Bowls Challenge (7-15 Oct. 2011, USA)
 - HK would send 2 male players to the event.
 - Application invitation had been sent to Squad members.
- 9.6 Japan Open (27-31 Oct. 2011, Japan)
 - HK would send a mixed triples team to the event.
 - Application invitation had been sent to Squad members.
- 9.7 World Singles Champion of Champions 2011 (6-13 Nov. 2011, HK)
 - Keep in view.
- 9.8 Asia Pacific Championships (28 Nov.-11 Dec. 2011, Australia)
 - HK would take part in the event.
 - Application invitation had been sent to Squad members.
- 9.9 Asian Championships 2011
 - It might be held in September in India. Details to be confirmed.

10. HKLBA Golden Jubilee Year 2011

- 10.1 China Inter-port Competition 2011 (21-22 May 2011, HK)
 - All arrangements were in order.
- 10.2 World Singles Champion of Champions 2011 (6-13 Nov. 2011, HK)
 - There was a record entry with 32 men and 34 women. 32 rinks, 32 markers and 6 ITOs were required at KBGC (12 rinks-Headquarters), KCC (6 rinks), USRC (6 rinks), FC (6 rinks) and CdeR (6 rinks) subject to confirmation. It may need 2 more rinks from KCC if CdeR could not provide the rinks.
 - Host venue clubs were advised to inform their F&B to reserve restaurant for the meals requirement for the duration of the event.
- 10.3 HKLBA Golden Jubilee International Mixed Pairs Classic 2011 (14-19 Nov. 2011, HK)
 - There would be 56 to 60 teams including 33 local clubs (\$3,000 per team), 18 overseas teams, 4-5 teams open for sale, 2-3 sponsored teams and one more sponsored team or open team to make it 60 teams.
 - The total prize money will be \$150,000.
- 10.4 Golden Jubilee magazine
 - It was expected to be ready in July or August. All members would get one copy and the magazines would be dispatched to Clubs.
- 10.5 Golden Jubilee souvenirs
 - The first batch of souvenirs was distributed for Triples league players already. The second batch of souvenirs would be distributed to Premier league players in due course.

11. ANY OTHER BUSINESS

- 11.1 VP-Technical reported that old year books would be added to the HKLBA website, though some of them were missing. The latest bye-laws were now on the website.
- 11.2 Mr. Peter Wong would step down as Convenor of HKCC. The President thanked him for his past support.
- 11.3 Annual dinner would be held on 20 May, there will be a record 468 attending (40 tables).
- 11.4 Ms. Elsie Luk has been employed by the Association as a part-time Development Officer.
