

義務秘書報告

2008至2009的香港草地滾球總會年度在2008年9月的週年大會中開展，其中七位現任委員在無競爭之下連任，而新加入的委員為主管聯賽的副會長梁卓雄先生。總會現時有32個屬會，年內並無新的屬會加入或退出。本年度的會務如常地繁忙運作，聯賽、公開賽、國際賽、特別賽事、同樂日、訓練課程、教練培訓、裁判培訓、地區推廣計劃、青少年發展計劃及青苗培訓計劃等。總會的網頁經常更新以提供最新資訊，亦備受球員歡迎。



在總會辦事處，幹事吳玉茹及程世寶仍舊每天努力不懈地完成繁重的日常會務、處理不斷更新的賽事及培訓課程。由於會務繁複，在工作日增的情況下人手必須增加，潘浩程先生(原為青年軍成員)被總會正式聘用為全職助理體育幹事，專責聯賽、公開賽及學校發展計劃。而原任兼職行政助理樊敏思在本年一月份呈辭，本人在此感謝她多年來的貢獻。然而，各委員們亦分別不間回報地義務貢獻各人的專長及時間，以確保會務運作暢順。為獲取康樂及文化事務署對草地滾球運動的持續支持，我們花費大量時間準時遞交財政、賽事等有關的報告及預算案，並得到該署撥款資助我們大部分的國際賽事。

我們同時感謝各界的贊助，包括中港擲球俱樂部、百佳(香港)有限公司、睡康寧床具(香港)有限公司、黃仲鳴先生、白小玲小姐、香港大塚製藥有限公司及郭新m先生。而菲律賓會及印度遊樂會也將一年一度的Ronson Au混合四人賽及印度遊樂會邀請賽的賽事報名費用全部捐贈予總會。

在國際賽方面，我們派隊參加了在馬來西亞舉行的亞太Merdeka「獨立日」單人、雙人及三人混合室內草地滾球錦標賽，在蘇格蘭舉行的世界冠中之冠單人賽，在美國舉行的Michael Ashton-Philips 國際盃邀請賽，在中國舉行的第七屆亞洲草地滾球錦標賽及第五屆亞洲廿五歲以下草地滾球錦標賽單人賽，在澳洲舉行的世界盃及世界青少年盃單人賽和老虎盃中國巡迴賽。在本港舉辦的比賽方面，我們派隊參加了香港國際草地滾球精英賽、香港足球會四人混合賽以及老虎盃。在派出香港隊參賽時，每次均需作出各項妥善安排，本人藉此向曾經協助籌備的義務工作人員致謝。亦藉此向曾經在本地賽事中當值、裁判及記分員等致以謝意。請大家緊記、我們歡迎任何會員隨時給與我們任何會務上的幫忙。

特別值得一提的是，我們的會長張旭峯先生於2008年12月15日獲得「民政事務局局長嘉許計劃」頒發表揚獎狀，以表揚他對草地滾球運動超過17年的卓越貢獻。張會長從1992年開始出任總會的義務助理秘書，及後當了六年的第一副會長，繼而出任會長至今。張會長是香港草地滾球總會自1961年創會以來最具經驗及歷任最久的委員。

總括來說，本屆的執行委員會共同譜出了熱鬧而富有成效的一年。

我們亦謹此向各位得獎者祝賀，未得獎的請加油，今年可能是你的天下！

Report by The Hon. Secretary

Dear Friends and Fellow Members,

The official 2008/2009 year began in September 2008 with our AGM and the uncontested re-election of 7 officers and the election of new officer Cyril Leung as Vice-President (national league). We retained our 32 associate member clubs, with no new entrants or resignations. Our year was as usual very busy, especially with the league and national competitions, international events, special events, fun-days, training courses for bowlers, coaches and umpires, district promotion programmes, the Youth Development programme and the Young Athletes Training Scheme. Our web-site remains very active, with constant updates for the competitions as well as other useful information.

In the office, Leona and Irene continued to work hard to keep up with the office's heavy workload on the routine tasks and the ever changing situations on the competitions and courses. With this very heavy work load, in order to keep up, it was necessary to employ additional staff. On 1 June 2008, Howard Poon, (our Youth Development Team member), was employed by us as a full-time assistant sports executive to help in particular with the league and national competitions, and schools development programmes. Regrettably, our very experienced part-time assistant, Man, resigned in January to take up a full-time job. Her many years of assistance was much appreciated. However, it is always very important that we elected officers contribute to the organization and management tasks as much as possible as sometimes our staffing resources are inadequate to enable us to serve you, our members, the best we can and ensure that our Association's activities run smoothly throughout the year. We undertook the piles of paper work required by our much valued subvention agency the Leisure and Cultural Services Department, without whom our activities would be severely restricted. We managed most of the time to keep to their deadlines for financial requests and reports and have had some success in obtaining their subvention for most of our international participations.

We also much appreciated the generous sponsorships received from the Zhong Gang Multi-Bowls Club, Pokka Corporation (HK) Limited, Suzuran Bed (HK) Ltd., Mr. Jacky Wong, Ms. Linda Pek, Otsuka Pharmaceutical (H.K.) Ltd. and Warren Kwok. Also, the annual events of Ronson Au Memorial Mixed Fours (by the Filipino Club) and the IRC Invitation Triples (by the Indian Recreation Club) generously donated all their entry fees.

On the International front, we sent teams to the Asia Pacific Merdeka Singles, Mixed Pairs & Mixed Triples Indoor Bowls Championship in Malaysia, the World Singles Champion of Champions in Scotland, the Michael Ashton-Philips International Challenge Cup in the United States of America, the 7th Asian Bowls Championship & 5th Asian Under-25 Singles Championship in China, the World Cup & World Junior Cup in Australia, the Tiger Bowls China Bowls Tour, and locally the International Bowls Classic, the Hong Kong Football Club Mixed- Fours and the Tiger Bowls tournaments. Sending our teams to these events entails a lot of work by our Association and our appreciation and thanks go to those few who have helped us as volunteers with the arrangements. Also very many thanks to our volunteer helpers, markers and umpires at our local events. Please all remember that we welcome any assistance from you, all our members, at any time.

Of special note, on 15 December 2008, our President Vincent Cheung received a Commendation Award from the Secretary for Home Affairs for his significant contribution to the sport of lawn bowls over his 17 years as a Hong Kong Lawn Bowls Officer, commencing his honorary service in 1992 as the Assistant Honorary Secretary. This was followed by 6 years as the 1st Vice-President, then President to the present. To date, Vincent is by far our longest serving Officer with the most experience since the formation of our Association in 1961.

All in all, we, the Executive Committee have had a very frantic, yet productive year.

And so in closing, Congratulations to all our last year's Winners and to the Losers, keep trying as this may be your year to be a Winner.

Wishing you all in all respects, a great 2009/2010 year.



A new page of history in the Hong Kong Classic

History was in the making at the Hong Kong International Bowls Classic 2008, firstly for the inaugural Ladies' Classic, but also for the record-breaking achievement of the England men's team, who became the first team to twice complete a Singles and Pairs "double".



The inaugural Ladies' Classic marked the complete amalgamation of the Hong Kong Lawn Bowls Association and the Hong Kong Ladies Lawn Bowls Association since the process was begun in 2002. This inaugural event celebrates that all bowlers in Hong Kong, despite their gender, can equally enjoy all the advantages and conveniences when they play the sport under a single management and governing body.



This year the Classic welcomed men and lady players from 11 overseas countries and was played at the Kowloon Bowling Green Club and Craiggower Cricket Club simultaneously from December 6-14.



In the Men's Singles, defending champion Mark Walton from England and previous winners David Peacock (Scotland) and Noel Kennedy (Hong Kong) all got past the first hurdle without much problem. Some of the overseas players however did feel the pressure from local players in the first round, with Tony Chiu (KBGC) beating Craig Maycock from Wales, Lee Ka Ho (HKLBA) defeated Fairul Izwan Abd Muin (Malaysia), Benson Fung (CCC) won over Melvin Tan (Singapore), and the two Thai representatives were also defeated by Tony Cheung (GLBC) and Sunny Tsui (HKSAP) respectively.



Moving into the quarter-finals on the second day of the Singles event, Ken Chan (HK) and Yu Hon Ming (AYFP) remained as the only two hopes for Hong Kong. However both of them lost to their opponents at this stage. Mert Issacman (USA) who ended Ken Chan's challenge to the title, lost to Mark Walton in the semi-finals and his compatriot Loren Dion also lost to Leif Selby (Australia) at the same stage.

In the Final, Walton dominated the first set, as Selby took time to settle. Selby came back in a keenly contested second set, but the Englishman was simply unstoppable in the tiebreaker after Selby, needing four shots to stay in the game, tried in vain to drive the jack into the ditch with his first delivery.

In the Ladies' Singles, the local ladies showed the overseas opponents their high quality of bowling in the first round, with Kelly Wong (CLBC) beating Sonia Bruce (Philippines), Linda Pek (LBTC) defeated Sharyn Renshaw (Australia), Venus Ngai (KCC) won over Hannah Smith (Wales), Winnie Au (HKFC) beat Bernie O'Neill (Ireland) and Candy Leung (CLBC) beating Thong Omen (Thailand).

Hong Kong International Bowls Classic 2008



On the second day in the quarter finals, Elizabeth Cormack (HK), Celena Kwok (KCC) and Grace Chu (HK) were defeated by their overseas opponents and so ending the locals challenge for the title.

Margaret Letham from Scotland, who defeated Malaysia's twice Commonwealth champion Siti Zalina Ahmad in the previous round, became the only UK player in the quarter-finals. She beat Elizabeth Cormack in this round and defeated New Zealand's world champion Val Smith on her way to the final. In the final she faced Canada's Shirley Ko, who is an immigrant from Hong Kong. Letham took the first set comfortably at 9-5 and in the second set she trailed 5-7 with one end to play but won the last end with two shots and became the first winner of the Ladies' Classic singles title.

The Pairs event took off at KBGC (ladies) and CCC (men's) respectively on December 8. In the Men's event, Group A leader Malaysia only lost one game to the HKLBA team in the group stage, and teams from HKLBA, Australia and Philippines also qualified for the knock-out stage. In group B, Scotland, England, KCC and New Zealand were also through. The defending champions, Hong Kong only finished sixth during the group stage and was eliminated.

In the quarter-finals, three Asian teams defeated their opponent and England, who beat Australia by 17:13, remained as the only western team in the semi-finals. Philippines and KCC defeated Scotland and HKLBA respectively to set up an all-Asia semi-final.

KCC won the semi-finals comfortable, beating Philippines 21:8 and England's Walton displayed a number of superb bowling skills to overcome the strong Malaysian team. In the final, Jimmy Chiu and Chadwick Chen from KCC tried their best to upset their opponent but the England pair proved too strong. The England team jumped to an eight-shot lead and never really looked back. The game ended at 20:7 and England's Walton became the first player to win the Classic Pairs twice.



Hong Kong International Bowls Classic 2008



In the Ladies' pairs, two local teams qualified for the knock-out stage including the Police and Sea Birds. Other qualifiers were Philippines, Australia, Wales, New Zealand, Malaysia and Scotland. In the quarter-finals, Scotland won over group A leader Philippines, Malaysia beat HKPBC 27:7, Wales beat New Zealand 27:8 and Sea Birds won over Australia 21:10.

In the semi-finals, the Welsh team ended the run of Sea Birds' Queenie Lai and Dreamy Ng in an evenly-contested match, whilst Malaysia ousted Scotland 19:14.

The final was quite a one-sided game as the Welsh team just could not match the drawing ability and the perfectly weighted take-out shots delivered by the two Malaysian players. The fact that the Welsh team only won three ends and the scoreline of 21:4 tells the story.

The expanded scale of the Hong Kong International Bowls Classic proved very successful and also opens up a new era in the history of lawn bowls in the world.

Youth Development

Youth Novice Competition

This competition was open to young bowlers aged under 25 and was successfully held at the Ap Lei Chau Sports Centre on 1 & 8 March 2009. A total of 34 participants took part in the event, most of them were players under our Young Athletes Scheme (YAS). They achieved excellent results. The champion was So Ka De, 1st runner-up was Po Ting Hei, 2nd runner-up was Chan Kwok Kit and 3rd runner-up was Cheung Ho Tin (all winners were YAS members).



Young Athletes Scheme

Launched in April 2006, the Scheme continues with the subvention from Leisure and Cultural Services Department. There are 3 centres located in Causeway Bay Victoria Park, Shatin Siu Lek Yuen Road and Tuen Mun Wu Shan bowling greens. There were a total of 23 and 30 participants for Phase 1 and Phase 2 respectively in 2008/2009. After the completion of this scheme, 10 players were selected to join our Youth Development Team.



Inter-schools Competition

With support from LCSD and Southern District Council this year for the first time, the competition will be held at the Ap Lei Chau Sports Centre on 17 May 2009. 16 schools with 50 primary and secondary students will participate. Compared with 24 students from 3 schools in last year's pilot competition, there is a significant increase. Similar competition will be organised again in future to arouse primary and secondary school students interest in lawn bowling.
