

2009至2010的香港草地滾球總會年度在2009年9月份的週年大會後展開，其中七位現任委員在無競爭之下連任，新加入的委員為主管公開賽的副會長趙楚輝先生以及一個全新設立的崗位，主管國際賽事的副會長劉曉昂先生。本年度並無新的屬會加入或退出，屬會總數仍維持為32個，會務一如往年非常繁忙地運作，並主要集中於聯賽、公開賽、國際賽、特別賽事、同樂日、訓練課程、教練培訓、裁判培訓、地區推廣計劃、青少年發展計劃及青苗培訓計劃等等。總會網頁的點擊率非常高，球員們除了檢視總會不斷更新的賽事資訊外，亦可以用以搜索其他草地滾球相關信息。

在總會辦事處，幹事吳玉茹、潘浩程及程世寶如常每天努力處理日常會務、處理不斷更新的賽事及培訓課程。值得留意的是，隨著會務日益繁多而總會的員工資源有限的情況下，我們這一群被選出來的委員們均會各自盡力為相關會務作出義務貢獻，以確保會內的各項活動和事務順暢運作。為讓我們的資助機構康樂及文化事務署繼續支持草地滾球運動，總會花費大量時間準時遞交財政、賽事等有關的報告及預算案等文件，並成功得到該署撥款資助我們大部分的國際賽事。

特別一提，新成立的金紫荊草地滾球會勇敢而成功地舉辦了首次跨會活動 - 金紫荊公開賽，賽事採用了一個不常用的賽制，隊伍的成員須要包括一隊男子雙人及一隊女子雙人組合。勝出隊伍不僅可以贏得獎金，更可以取得香港國際草地滾球精英賽的參賽資格。金紫荊草地滾球會的努力亦在該賽事得到好評的情況下得到肯定。

在國際賽方面，我們派隊參加了在馬來西亞舉行的亞太Merdeka「獨立日」室內草地滾球錦標賽、亞太錦標賽、在蘇格蘭舉行的世界冠中之冠單人賽、在美國舉行的 Michael Ashton-Philips 國際盃邀請賽、在中國舉行的第八屆亞洲草地滾球錦標賽及第六屆亞洲廿五歲以下草地滾球錦標賽單人賽、中國巡迴賽，在澳門舉行的中港澳邀請賽、在澳洲舉行的世界盃及世界青少年盃單人賽，和在本地舉行的香港國際草地滾球精英賽及老虎盃。香港隊每次出賽時，總會需要作出各項籌備及支援，藉此向曾經提供協助的義務工作人員及領隊致謝。我們亦向曾經在本地賽事中當值的裁判及記分員等致以謝意。請大家緊記、我們歡迎任何會員隨時給與我們任何會務上的幫忙。

Entering our teams in these events entails a lot of work by our Association and our appreciation and thanks go to those who have helped us, especially as team managers, with the arrangements. Also very many thanks to our volunteer helpers, markers and umpires at our local events. Please all remember that we welcome any assistance from you, all our members, at any time.





The Hong Kong International Bowls Classic 2009 saw over 120 men and women bowlers from 12 countries and regions competing for the Pairs and Singles titles in the 9-day tournament. The island-side clubs were hosting the event this time, thanks to the generosity of the Craigengower Cricket Club, Hong Kong Football Club and Indian Recreation Club for use of their greens and club facilities.

Continued with the inaugural success, the women's section went strong into its second year. This time, the Hong Kong Lawn Bowls Association blended the men's and women's fixtures at every venue. This arrangement provided a better spectacle for bowling fans and was popular with players alike.

Another difference that all should notice was the Australasian domination. Contrary to 2008 when the Northern Hemisphere countries ruled, the Kiwis were taking the Men's Pairs and Women's Singles titles while the Aussies were winning in the Women's Pairs and Men's Singles.

Australian Leif Selby was always the one to beat in the Singles. The reigning World Cup winner who came with a vengeance did not drop one single set en route to taking the Men's title. Having had to settle for second best to England's Mark Walton in the previous year, Selby made no mistake this time trouncing Classic debutant Hommer Mercado of the Philippines in two straight sets in the final. The Filipinos had fought gamely throughout the weekend including beating Scotland's Alister Kennedy in the extra end of the tie-break in the semi-final!

Perhaps not as fortunate was World No. 1 Safuan Said whose day was ended prematurely by China's Ye Sui Ying in the second round, providing one of the few upsets in the tournament.

Four local players reached the 3rd round on the first day of the Singles tournament, namely John Lunn, Paul Lee, Kenny Tam and Ken Chan. However, the last of Hong Kong hopes was dashed when Lee of Craigengower was knocked out by Wales's Martin Selway at the quarter-final, subsequent to Lee himself ousting England's Mark Bantock in the earlier round.

The Women's Singles champion also came through her games without dropping a set. A Hong Kong Classic debutant, Genevieve Baildon of New Zealand proved herself invincible conceding only four ends in the final to Canadian Josephine Lee, who had to settle for silver like her Pairs partner Shirley Ko in last year.


In fact, the two Singles finalists of last year did not fare well in the early stages. Ko lost a tight battle to Mercredi Yeung of United Services Recreation Club in the opening round; while Florence Lau of Filipino Club defeated the defending champion Scotland's Margaret Letham in the following round.

Six local ladies reached the 3rd round but none broke through to the quarter-finals. In addition to Lau, they were Doris Pang, Olivia Yu, Queenie Lai, Annie Yeung and Camilla Leung.

In the Men's Pairs, three local teams were qualified for the knock-outs after the 5-day group stage. They were Hong Kong, Craigengower Cricket Club and Kowloon Bowling Green Club. It was KBGC's Heron Lau and James Cheng who produced the best achievement of the locals by beating England in one of the greatest rallies of the week to reach semi-final.

The KBGC partners were trailing by 12 points with five ends to go in the quarter-final. The turning point came when England dropped 5 shots in the 14th where Lau and Cheng gained their second wind. In the 18th end, England was lying shot when the KBGC skip played a perfectly-weighted wrestling shot to gain 2 points in a measure to send the game into the extra end. KBGC scored again to just nudge out England.

The crowd at the quarter-finals at the Craigengower on this Classic Saturday was treated to some entertaining bowling. Numerous rounds of applause resonated at the CCC clubhouse, particularly so whenever a brilliant bowl was delivered by Kevin Fung or Robin Chok, who did Craigengower proud playing an excellent game on their home turf against Gary Kelly and Neil Booth of Ireland.

However, Hong Kong had to settle for joint 3rd when the KBGC combination was overshadowed by two young men from New Zealand, the eventual champions Richard Collet and Andrew Kelly. The Classic debutants displayed tremendous tenacity when beating fellow Antipodeans in the quarter-final defying the strong late rally from team Michael Cronin and Leif Selby, which were unbeaten at group stage. New Zealand went on to beat Malaysia in the final where big counts were scattered all over the score card.

The best Pairs performance of local ladies came from Grace Chu and Sonia Chan. Representing Hong Kong, the pair reached the quarter-final after finishing 4th in their group in the preliminary, only to be defeated by the eventual champions Australia's Kelsey Cottrell and Julie Keegan.

The golden girls proved to be unstoppable with their trademark white bowls. The combination did not drop one single match during the Pairs week. Though they had their nervous moments in the group stage, it was all plain sailing for Cottrell and Keegan in the finals weekend including beating defending champion Siti Zalina Ahmad and Nor Hashimah Ismail of Malaysia in the final by 22-12.

The tight game with the Philippines in the quarter-final might have hinted the demise of the Malaysian pair, who just got up in the penultimate end. The other teams that made the frame for knock-out stage were England, New Zealand, Scotland and last year's runner-up Wales.

These must be a most enjoyable nine days in the Hong Kong bowling calendar for bowlers, fans and workers at the Hong Kong Classic. And it was all appropriately rounded up in the presentation dinner with a traditional Chinese banquet at the Craigengower clubhouse where lots of prizes and gifts were given, lots of hearty words of appreciation were exchanged and lots and lots of flashes were fired.

Report on 1st Japan International Open 2009


